

# ASPAW! – What Is It?

## Anti Smoking Planning Action Workshop

ASPAW is a workshop developed specifically for the Smokefree Strategic Plan and is fully run by students with the support of Senior Management. The workshop is put in place instead of a detention that students would usually take as punishment for being caught smoking at school or in uniform. Students do have the option to take the detention or ASPAW and are informed by senior management that ASPAW is the best option for the students. The workshop takes 3 sessions that are held in the Whare Awhina at Kapiti College. The Whare Awhina will be the main base for ASPAW. Many of the sessions will be held after school although some smaller sessions may be held during lunchtimes. Students running ASPAW will be fully trained and will be apart of the Smokefree Advisory Group.
